

SHOOTING A SCREEN TEST

BARRETT CASTING

1. Make sure we can see and hear you clearly.
2. Only perform the dialogue of your character. Don't worry too much about the actions.
3. Have someone read the other characters in the scene – even if they aren't an actor. Have them stand right next to the camera so the eye line of the actor is just to the left or right of the camera (NOT looking directly at the camera at any point in the scene).
4. Shoot the screen test in a medium close up. A medium close up is a shot of the actors' head and shoulders only.
5. Please include a long shot AT THE END stating your name, age, height and location
